APPLYING TO ACES 2021 – Frequently Asked Questions

Can I apply for more than one category (Visual Art, Performance, Workshop/Presentation/Open Forum/Listening Session)?

Yes, but please submit a separate application for each category.

How will the visual arts be presented during ACES?

The visual art will be exhibited at <u>ARTS at King Street Station</u> in Seattle. The exhibit will be viewable via an online virtual tour, the link will be provided for all those that register. The availability of in-person tours will depend on Washington state's health and safety protocols at the time of the event on May 15-16, 2021.

If I have multiple people in my presentation/performance, will everyone get paid?

Yes, every participant will be paid \$100.

If I participate in ACES in more than one way, i.e. have art being exhibited and serving on a panel, will I get paid for both?

Yes.

Is there an age limit to present at ACES?

No. The voices of our youth are welcome and encouraged to apply and participate.

What is an artist talk?

Artist Talks are opportunities for visual artists to speak about their work and take questions from attendees.

If I've presented my work before, is it still eligible to be part of ACES?

Yes.

When will we be notified regarding our application status?

Final selections will be made, and artists will be notified, in mid-March.
